1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard Mr. S.K.Biswal, learned counsel for the petitioners and Miss S. Mishra, learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. Being aggrieved by the order dtd. 20.12.2021 passed in Spl. Case No. 363 of 2016 by the Learned Adhoc Addl. Sessions Judge, (FTSC), Balasore issuing order of NBWA, the petitioners have approached this Court. While prima facie, this Court does not find any infirmity in the order passed but in order to allow the petitioners to effectively defend themselves, it is directed that, in the event, the petitioners surrender within a period of three weeks hence, they shall be released on bail on earlier terms.

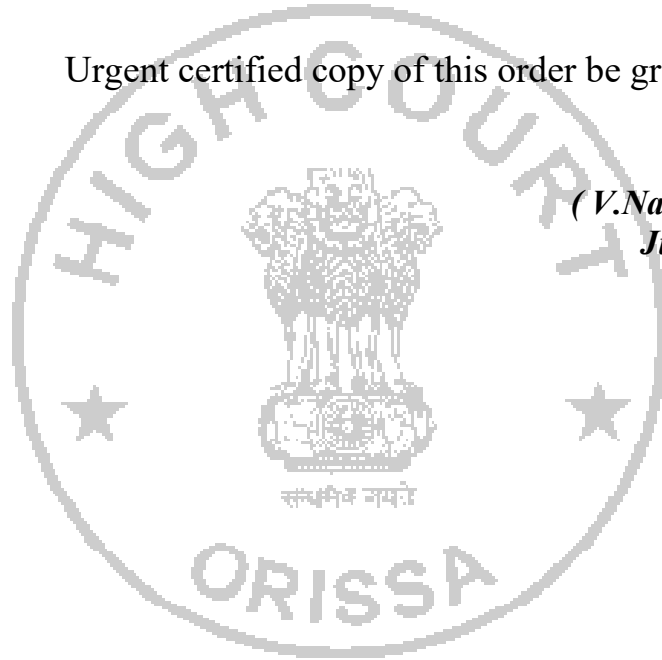
4. It is made clear that, in the event the petitioners do not surrender within the time fixed, it shall be open to the prosecution to take effective steps in terms of the impugned order.
