This is an application under section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in connection with Bansada P.S. Case No.77 of 2022

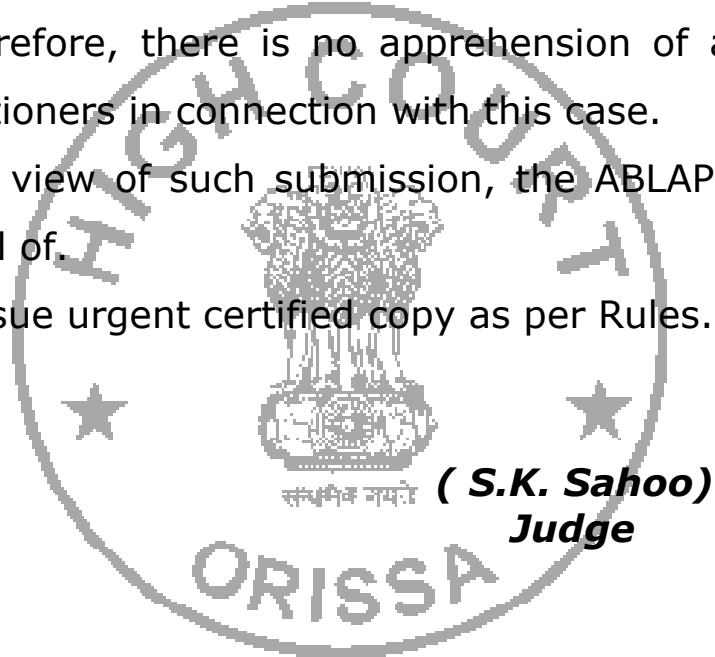
