03. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned Counsel for the State.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner for anticipatory bail, involving offence punishable under Sections 341/294/324/307/506, I.P.C.
4. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of the offence and facts of the case, although I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioners, however it is observed that, in the event the Petitioner surrenders and moves for bail before the learned S.D.J.M., Jagatsinghpur in G.R. Case No.156 of 2022 corresponding to Jagatsinghpur P.S. Case No.65 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, but subject to verification of

criminal antecedents against the Petitioner as well as subject to verification of Injury Report. If it is found that there is more than one criminal antecedent of similar nature against the Petitioner, then this bail order shall automatically stand revoked. Similarly, if the injuries caused to the victim are found to be serious in nature, then also this bail order shall stand automatically revoked.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
6. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rules.
