1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is in custody since 20.07.2021 in connection with Belghar P.S. Case No. 12 of 2021 corresponding to C.T. Case No.24 of 2021 pending in the court of learned Addl. District and Sessions Judge - cum- Special Court under POCSO Act, Phulbani for the alleged commission of offence under Sections 376(3)/376(2)(n) of IPC read with Section 6 of POCSO Act.

Considering the submissions, the materials on record, the period of detention already undergone and in particular the statement of the victim recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail. Let the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the court in seisin over the matter may deem fit and proper to impose including the condition that he shall personally appear before the trial Court on each date of posting of the case without fail.
