2.        The Petitioners in this writ petition seek to assail the order dated 7<sup>th</sup> February, 2020(Annexure-5) passed by the Joint Commissioner, Settlement and Consolidation, Cuttack in Consolidation Revision No.131 of 2012, which was dismissed for default.
