2016 arising out of Baramba P.S. Case No. 67 of 2016, on the file of learned Presiding Officer, Special Court, SC & ST(PoA) Act, Cuttack, stands quashed in respect of the Petitioners in exercise of power under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
