01. 1. This writ petition involves the following prayer:

“It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that Your Lordship would be graciously pleased to admit this application, issue notice to the Opp.Parties and after hearing the parties, direct the Opp.Parties, i.e. Opp.Party No.4 to consider the prayer of the petitioners and take decision or any action on the said application dated 28.02.2022 filed by the petitioner No.2 under **Annexure-4** within a stipulated period of time as this Hon’ble Court may deem fit and proper;”
