01. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in connection with Dhamara P.S. Case No. 29 of 2022 corresponding to G.R. Case No.205 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Chandbali for the commission of the alleged offences punishable under sections 279, 307, 379, 411/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Perused the F.I.R. annexed to the anticipatory bail application.

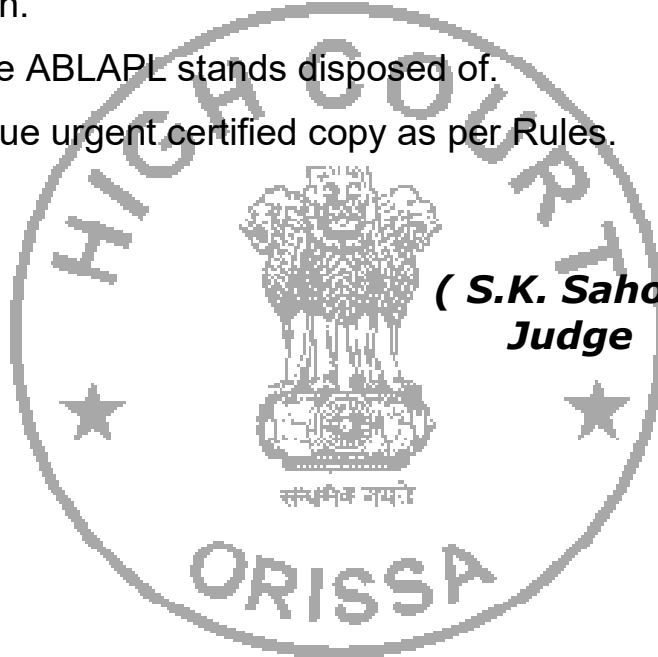
In view of the nature of accusation against the petitioners and particularly when allegation of attempt to

murder to a public servant on duty is there and the petitioners are having criminal antecedents, while not inclining to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, liberty is granted to them to surrender and move for bail in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today in the event of which the learned Courts below shall dispose of the same in accordance with law expeditiously and the claim of parity with the co-accused persons, who are stated to have been released on bail, shall be taken into account. The case records shall be made available to the Courts concerned for disposal of the bail application.
