1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is in custody since 23.06.2021 in connection with Dargha Bazar P.S. Case No.28 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No.433 of 2021 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M.(S), Cuttack for the alleged commission of offence under Section 392 of IPC.
4. Considering the submissions, materials on record, the period of detention in custody and the fact that some of the stolen articles had already been recovered, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail. Let the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the court in seisin over the matter may deem fit and proper to impose including the condition that he shall appear before the IIC of Aska Police Station once on every Monday at 10 a.m. for a period of six months and such fact shall be certified by the IIC of the concerned Court once every month.
5. BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
