01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).

The entire exercise shall be completed within a period of three months thereafter from the date of communication of a copy of this order along with a copy of the Writ Petition by the Petitioner and also the order of this Court in W.P.(C) No.2831 of 2016, the order of the Hon'ble apex Court in Diary No.(s) 20358 of 2017 and also the order of this Court in W.P.(C) No.29120 of 2019 by the Petitioner.
5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
