1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is in custody since 08.02.2022 in connection with Laikera P.S. Case No.8 of 2022 corresponding to C.T. Case No.57 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Jharsuguda for the alleged commission of offence under Section 379/511/120-B/34 of IPC read with Section 3 & 4 of Explosive Substances Act, Sections 3 & 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act and Sections 15(2) & 15(4) of the Petroleum and Minerals Pipelines (Acquisition of Right of User in Land) Amendment Act, 2011.
4. As it appears, FIR was lodged against unknown persons. In course of investigation, the petitioner, who was in custody in another case, was interrogated, during which he is supposed to confess his guilt. There is no other material to show his involvement in the alleged occurrence.

5. Having regard to the above facts, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail. Let the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the court in seisin over the matter may deem fit and proper to impose including the condition that he shall personally appear before the trial Court on each date of posting of the case without fail.

6. BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
