1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Petitioner in this RPFAM seeks to assail the order dated 11th October, 2021 (Annexure-4) passed by learned Judge, Family Court, Balasore in Cr.P. No.8 of 2018, which was allowed *ex parte* directing him to pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- as maintenance per month to the Opposite Party.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that interest of justice will be best served if the Petitioner files an application before the learned Judge, Family Court, Balasore under Section 126 (2) Cr.P.C. to set aside the *ex parte* order and prays for withdrawal of the RPFAM.
