This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in connection with Kendrapara P.S. Case No.37 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No. 532 of 2021 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Kendrapara for commission of alleged offences under sections 341 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the State on instruction submitted that the injured is one Sk.Nasim, who has sustained simple injuries. He further submitted that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedents.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the ingredients of the offence under section 307 of the Indian Penal Code against the petitioner are not attracted and that the injured has sustained simple injuries, I am inclined to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail and accordingly, this Court directs that in the event of arrest of the petitioner in connection with the aforesaid case, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer with further conditions that he shall make himself available for interrogation by the I.O. as and when required and he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing any facts to the Courts or to the Investigating Officer.

Violation of any of the above conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
