5. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
2. Petitioner, in this writ petition, prays for the following reliefs:-

“Petitioner therefore prays that this Hon’ble Court be kind enough to admit the writ petition, issue notices to opposite parties especially O.P. No.4 to file show cause on representation and if the O.P. fails to file show cause or insufficient case than this Hon’ble Court after hearing the counsel for parties be pleased to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus.
