1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the appellant as well as learned counsel for the State.
3. It is seen from the record that the alleged offence under Sections 363/376(2)(n), I.P.C. read with Section 3(2)(v) of the S.C. and S.T. (PoA) Act read with Section 6 of the POCSO Act and Section 3(2)(v)(va) of the S.T. and S.C. (PA) Act. Hence, this appeal is not maintainable. Therefore, the appellant shall file BLAPL application before this Court.
