3. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. The Petitioner in this writ petition prays for a direction to the Opposite Party Nos. 3 to 5 to supply electricity to the premises of the Petitioner-Company.
3. Both Mr. Sahoo, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. Tripathy, learned counsel for Opposite Party No.6 submit that power supply to the premises of the Petitioner-Company has already been restored in the meantime. In that view of the matter, this writ petition has become infructuous.
