1. This matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.
 2. Heard Mr.B.K.Hati, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.D.K.Mohanty, learned Addl. Standing Counsel.
 3. According to Mr.Hati the petitioner is aggrieved by action of the authorities whereby they have enlisted many ineligible persons for extending them the benefits under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana under the Grama Panchayat Chanabahal. His further grievance is that though the petitioner is eligible to get the benefits of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana however his case has been ignored.
 4. During course of hearing, Mr. Hati submits that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to move the Collector & District Magistrate, Bolangir (opposite party No.3) in the matter by filing a grievance petition and the said opposite party be directed to take a decision on such motion at an early date.
 5. Considering the submissions made and without

expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court grants liberty to the petitioner to file a grievance petition before opposite party No.3 through registered post within a period of two weeks from today. In the event, such a petition is filed along with a copy of this order, the opposite party No.3 would do well to take a decision on the same in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of such grievance petition and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this CRLMP is disposed of.

7. Urgent certified copy of the order be granted on proper application.
