1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. The Petitioner in this writ petition prays for a direction for early disposal of C.P. No. 23 of 2018 filed by the Petitioner under Section 13(1) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, which is pending before learned Judge, Family Court, Puri.
3. It is submitted by Mr. Pradhan, learned counsel for the Petitioner that although the Petitioner has led evidence, but the matter is being adjourned to different dates for his cross-examination. Due to non-cooperation of Opposite Party, mediation has also failed and the matter is being dragged on for which the Petitioner is highly prejudiced. Hence, the Petitioner prays for a direction for the aforesaid relief.
4. Taking into consideration the submission made by learned counsel for the Petitioner and volume of pendency of such nature of cases before learned Judge, Family Court, Puri, I am not inclined to entertain the prayer made in this writ petition. However, the Petitioner, if so advised, may file an application for early disposal of C.P. No. 23 of 2018 stating the grounds therein and in that

event, learned Judge, Family Court, Puri may consider the same and proceed with the matter in accordance with law.

5. With the aforesaid observation, this writ petition is disposed of.
