03. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in connection with G.R.G.N. Case No.119 of 2022 arising out of Brahmagiri P.S. Case No.52 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned Nyayadhikari, Grama Nyayalaya, Brahmagiri for alleged commission of offences under sections 147/148/336/427/307/294/506/186/353/149 of the Indian Penal

Code read with sections 3 and 4 of the Explosive Substances Act, 1908.

Perused the F.I.R.

Learned counsel for the State on instruction submitted that the petitioners nos.4, 5 and 6, namely, Yudhisthir Pradhan @ Yudhisthir Parida, Bidyadhara Parida and Tapas Pradhan respectively have criminal antecedents.

In view of such submission, while not inclining to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners nos.4, 5 and 6, it is observed that in the event the petitioners nos.4, 5 and 6, namely, Yudhisthir Pradhan @ Yudhisthir Parida, Bidyadhara Parida and Tapas Pradhan respectively surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and moves for bail, the same shall be disposed of as expeditiously as possible by the Courts below in accordance with law. The case records shall be made available to the Court concerned.

Learned counsel for the State further submitted that nobody has sustained any injury.

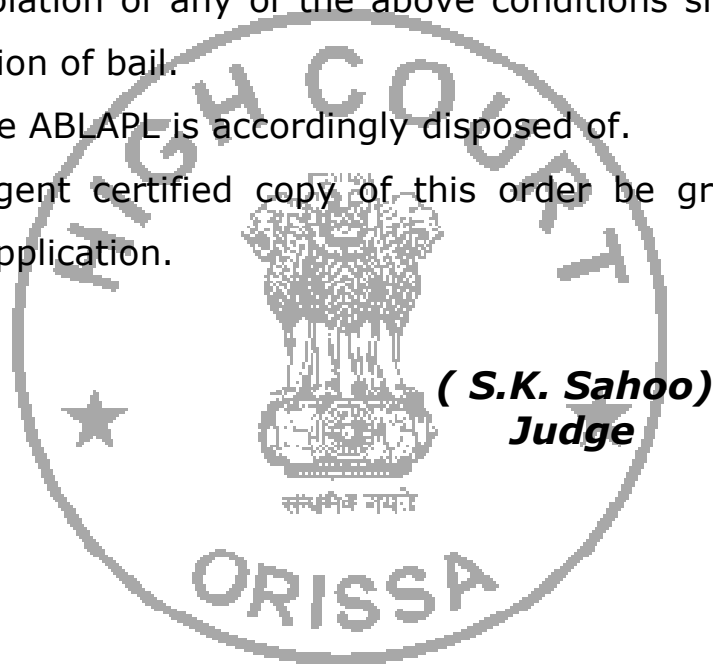
Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the respective parties, absence of any criminal antecedent against the petitioners nos.1, 2 and 3, namely, Bhaskara Dalai, Kangres Pradhan and Dibakar Parida respectively and the fact that nobody has sustained any injury, I am inclined to release them on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, this Court directs that in the event of arrest of petitioners nos.1, 2 and 3, namely, Bhaskara Dalai, Kangres Pradhan and Dibakar Parida respectively in

connection with the aforesaid case, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer with further conditions that they shall make themselves available for interrogation by the I.O. as and when required and they shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to the Investigating Officer.

Violation of any of the above conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
