3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“The petitioner therefore prays that your Lordships would be graciously pleased to admit this writ petition, call for the records, after hearing the parties issue writ/writs in the nature of certiorari/mandamus or any other writ/directions directing the Special Land Acquisition Officer, R.I.P (Opp. Party No.3) to accept the application under Annexure-1 for reassessment of compensation amount and consider the same within a stipulated period”.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting his grievance, the Petitioner has made a representation to Opposite Party No.3 vide Annexure-1 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.
