02. 1. Heard Mr. P.K. Satapathy, learned counsel for the Petitioners and Mr. D. Moharana, learned Standing Counsel for Vigilance department.
2. It is submitted that Petitioner No.1 was released on bail on 9th November, 2016 and Petitioner No.2 was released on bail on 3rd April, 2019 by the learned Special Judge (Vigilance), Phulbani in G.R. No.119(V) of 2013. The alleged offences are under Sections 13(2) read with Section 13(1)(c) of the P.C. Act, 1988 and under Section 409/120-B of the I.P.C. Subsequently, due to non-appearance of Petitioners for the reason of illness, NBW of arrest was issued against them vide order dated 16th March, 2022 by rejecting their petition filed under Section 317 Cr.P.C.
3. Thus considering the limited nature of prayer and after hearing learned counsel for the State, in the interest of justice, the CRLMC is disposed of with a direction that in the event the Petitioners surrender

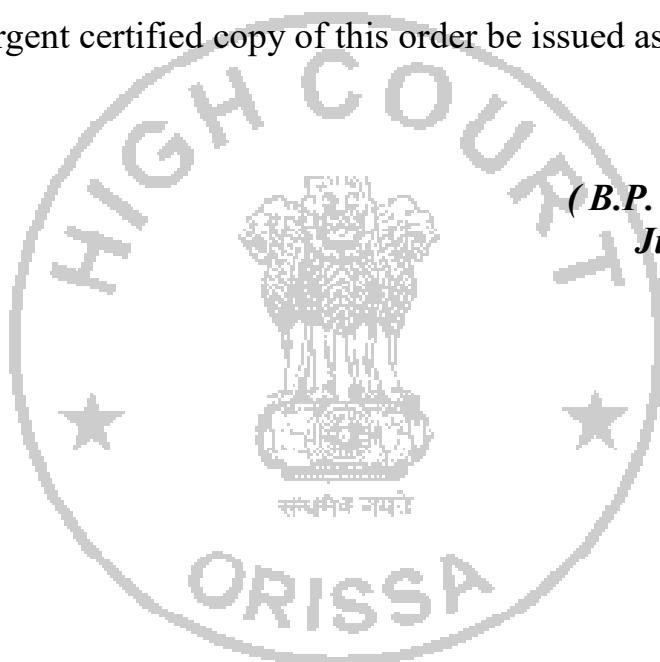
on or before 27th April, 2022 before the learned court below and move for bail, they be released on bail in the aforesaid case on such terms and conditions to be fixed by the learned court below in seisin over the matter including the condition that they shall attend the court on each date fixed.

4. It is made clear that failing to surrender within the time stipulated above, this order shall not be given effect to.

5. The CRLMC is disposed of.

6. An urgent certified copy of this order be issued as per rules.
