1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard Mr. M. Panda, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. K.K. Gaya, learned counsel for the State.
3. This is an application under Section-438 Cr.P.C. for anticipatory bail.
4. The petitioner is stated to be the mother-in-law of the informant. she is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Cuttack Mahila P.S. Case No. 30 of 2022 corresponding to G.R. Case No. 330 of 2022 pending in the Court of S.D.J.M.(S), Cuttack for commission of offence punishable under Sections-498(a)/ 323/294/506/34 of the I.P.C.

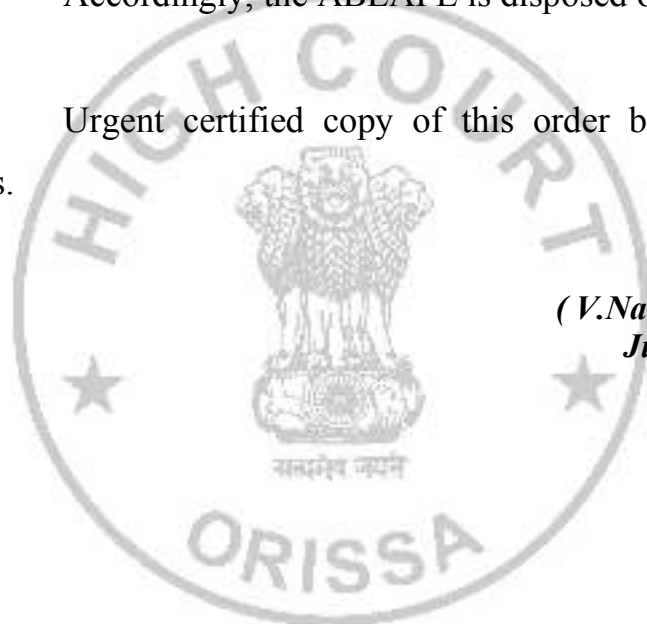
5. Perused the Written Complaint.
