2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite party authority to treat the petitioner as qualified tenderer and after completion of tender process since it being the L1 bidder, the said contract may be awarded to it.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made representation before the opposite party-General Manager, Food Corporation of India vide Annexure-3, and the same may be directed to be disposed of taking into consideration Annexures-4 & 5 within a stipulated time.
