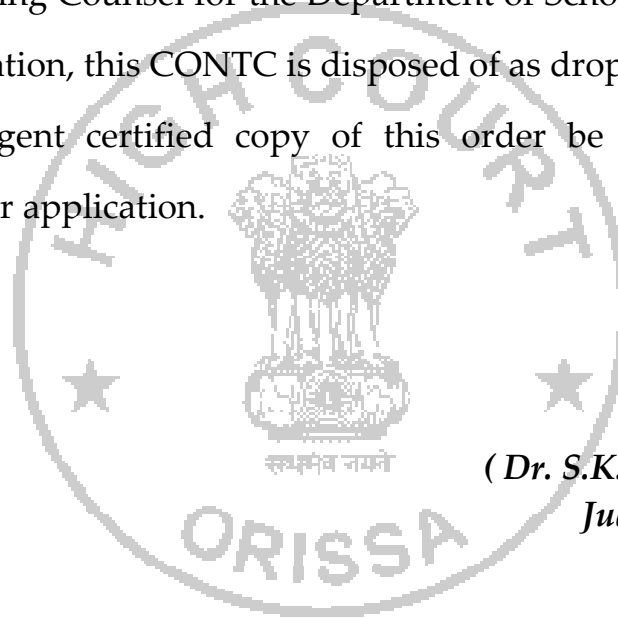
01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
