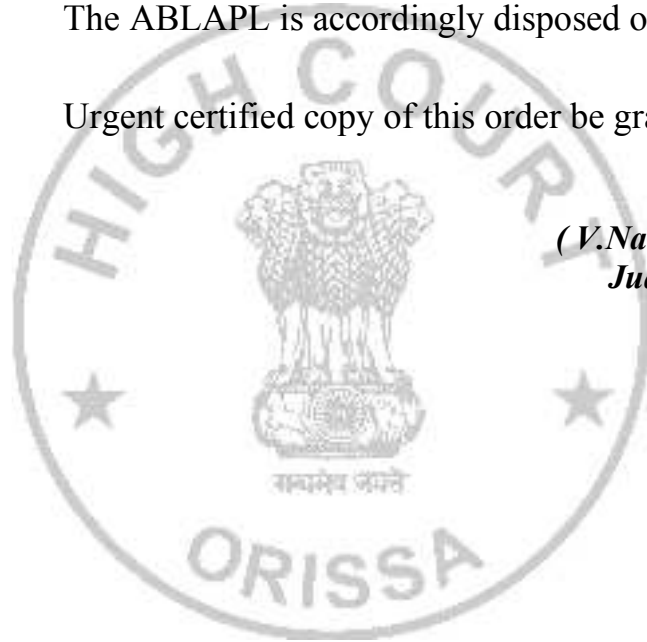
Jajpur Road for the alleged commission of the offence punishable under Sections 341/294/323/307/325/379/34, of the I.P.C.
