1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.278 of 2022 arising out of Basudevpur P.S. Case No.127 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Basudevpur for commission of offence punishable under Sections 341/452/294/323/427/354/307/354-B/506/34 of I.P.C.
