1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
 2. The Petitioner having been implicated in Attabira P.S. Case No.23 of 2020 corresponding to C.T. Case No.23 of 2020 registered for alleged commission of offence under section 417/323/376 of the IPC, pending on the file of learned NGN, Attabira, has filed this application under section 438 of the Cr.P.C. for his grant of anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in the above mentioned case.
 3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
 4. Considering the submissions and viewing the materials on record as also other surrounding circumstances, while being not inclined grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioner, this application is disposed of with the observation that when the occasion would so arise before the learned Court in seisin of the case to consider the prayer for grant of regular bail to the

Petitioner, the same shall be considered on its own merit; further taking into account all such developments which have taken place in the meantime in their proper perspective and disposed of early in accordance with law, so as to enable the Petitioner to move the next higher forum early in case necessity so arises.

The case record be made available at the cost of the Petitioner.

Interim order passed on 08.05.2020 stands vacated

5. The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
