1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Nilgiri P.S. Case No. 350 of 2021 corresponding to C.T. Case No. 514 of 2021, pending on the file of the learned SDJM, Nilgiri for commission of offence under Sections 341/294/323/379/427/506/34 of the I.P.C.

Taking into account the nature of allegation and on perusal of the complaint petition on the basis of which the F.I.R. has been instituted citing the petitioner as an accused, it is directed that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the petitioner shall be released on bail by the learned court in seisin over the matter on such terms as deemed just and proper.
