1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.324 of 2022 arising out of Thakurgarh P.S. Case No.96 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned S.D. J.M., Athmallik for commission of offence punishable under Sections 498(A)/294/506/34 of the IPC read with Section 4 D.P. Act.
4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is the husband. Considering the nature of allegations and the submissions made by the learned counsel for the State and for the petitioner, it is directed that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the petitioner shall be released on bail
