01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/ physical) mode.
2. During course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioners prays for withdrawal of this bail application in respect of the Petitioner No.1. Accordingly, this application stands disposed of as withdrawn in respect of Petitioner No.1. The ABLAPL is now confined only to Petitioner Nos. 2 to 6, hereinafter referred to as 'the Petitioners'.
3. Heard learned Counsel for the Petitioners and learned Counsel for the State.
4. Considering the submissions and on going through the charge-sheet submitted and the nature of accusations; further keeping in view the surrounding circumstances of the case as also concerning the Petitioners and in the absence of any other impediment, it is directed that in the event the Petitioners surrender before the Court in seisin of the case in Konark P.S. Case No.83 of 2022 corresponding to G.R. Case No.227 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Konark within three weeks hence and move for their release on bail, they shall be released on bail on such

terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the said Court with further condition that they will not threaten or terrorize the prosecution witnesses in any manner.

5. The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
