1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
2. Petitioner in this writ petition prays for the following reliefs:-

“The petitioner therefore prays that Your Lordship may be pleased to consider the fact stated above and admit the Writ Application and after hearing the parties, necessary direction may be issued to Opp. Party No.3 to be allowed the foot path as per agreement as public road.
