1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No. 92 of 2022, arising out of Tangi P.S. Case No. 96 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned N.G.N.-cum-J.M.F.C., Tangi for the alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections 341/294/323/379/506/34 of the I.P.C.
4. Taking into account the nature of allegation in respect of Petitioner No.1-Gadadhara Patra, his Anticipatory Bail stands rejected.

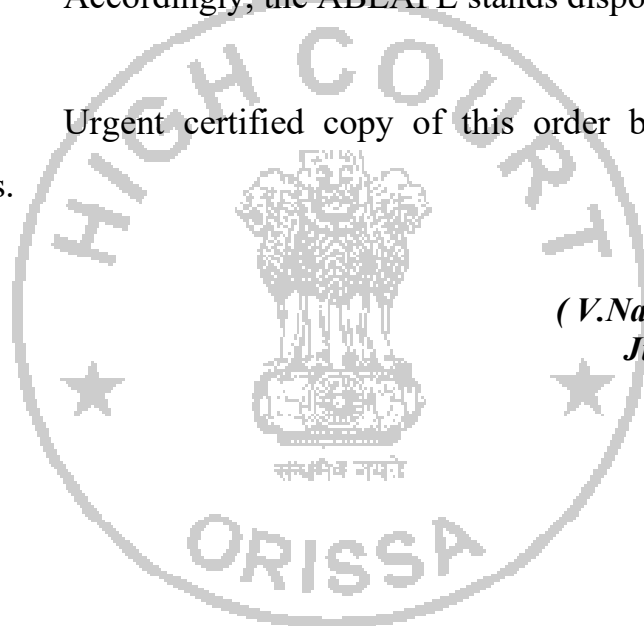
