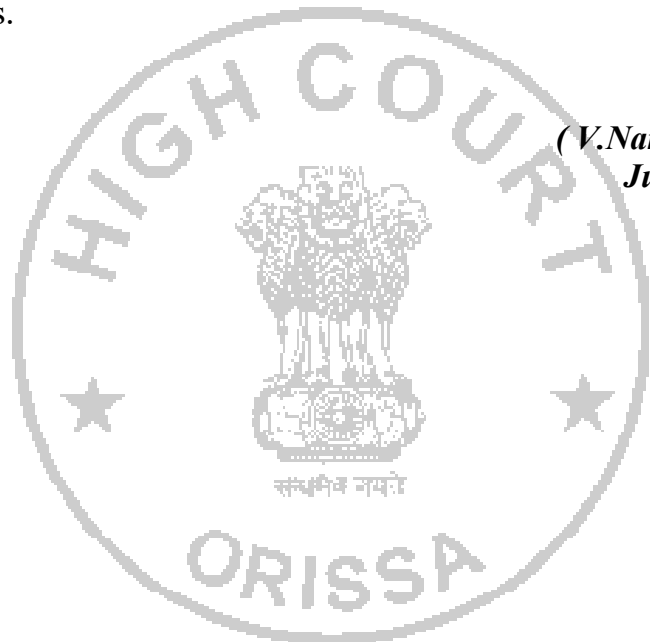
1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No. 267 of 2022, arising out of Tomaka P.S. Case No. 24 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Jajpur Road for the alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections-143/147/148/341/323/294/336/427/353/395/511/506/149 of the I.P.C.
4. Taking into account the Order passed by this Court dtd. 29.03.2022 in ABLAPL No. 2434 of 2022 and Order passed by this Court dtd. 18.05.2022 in ABLAPL No. 3922 of 2022, this
