1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.

3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Rajkanika P.S. Case No. 70 of 2019 corresponding to G.R. Case No. 107 of 2019, pending on the file of the learned JMFC, Aul for commission of offence under Sections 341/323/324/394/506/307/34 of the I.P.C.
