upon insufficient causes shown make the said rule absolute and may pass such other order/orders as deemed just and proper.

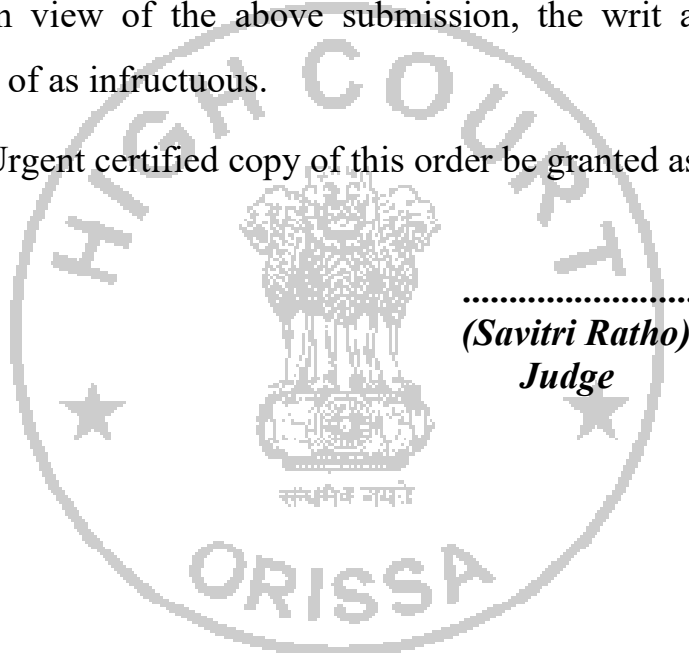
