2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to waive off the penalty of 1% as levied upon the petitioner over value of works executed from the date of 26.03.2015.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made representation before the opposite party no.2-Engineer-in-Chief, Rural Works, Odisha, BBSR under Annexure-14, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned Additional Government Advocate has no objection.
