1. Heard Mr. S. Sahoo, learned counsel for the Appellants and Mr. J. Nayak, learned C.G.C. for Respondent No.1-Union of India.

2. It is submitted on behalf of the Appellants that challenge in the present appeal against the direction of keeping 90% of the compensation amount in fixed deposit is covered by a similar judgment of this Court.

3. It is admitted by both parties that the challenge in the present appeal is squarely covered by the decision of this Court rendered in FAO No.262 of 2020 and batch, disposed of on 9th September, 2021.

4. Accordingly, the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the principles decided in the said decision of this Court with a direction to disburse entire compensation amount in favour of the claimants by keeping 50% of shares of Appellant No.1 –

Satyabhama Raul in separate fixed deposits in any Nationalized Bank in her name for a period of five years. The entire amount fall due to the share of minor viz. Appellant No.2—Aswini Kumar Raul be kept in any Nationalized Bank in separate fixed deposits till he attains majority or for a period of five years, whichever is later.
