1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioners are stated to be the members of the family of the in-laws of the informant.
4. The petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No. 352 of 2022, arising out Nimapara P.S. Case No. 112 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Nimapara for the alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections 498(A)/341/294/323/506/34 of the I.P.C and read with Section-4 of the D.P. Act.
