1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.521 of 2022, arising out of Sundargarh Town P.S. Case No.109 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned SDJM, Sundargarh for commission of offence punishable under Sections 147/148/294/323/353/332/506/149 of the IPC.
