1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/ Physical Mode).
2. Mr. S.S. Kanungo, learned Addl. Government Advocate appearing for the State has produced a written instruction that he has received from I.I.C., Marine Police Station, Jamboo, District-Kendrapara. From the said instruction as well as from the statements recorded under Sections 161 of the Cr.P.C. and 164 of the Cr.P.C., it transpires that the victim is a major and she had left the house voluntarily and stayed at Delhi with his relation.
