Referring the order-sheet at Annexure-4 and also the impugned order, Mr. Behera, learned counsel for the Petitioners submitted that there was in fact several adjournments of the matter involved on Covid-19 ground and even though the Opposite Parties therein prepared their response, it could not be filed for the prevailing situation there.
