1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.220 of 2022, arising out of Joda P.S. Case No.65 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Barbil for commission of offence punishable under Sections 147/148/341/323/294/353/332/186/153-A/295-A/120-B/506/149 of the IPC.
