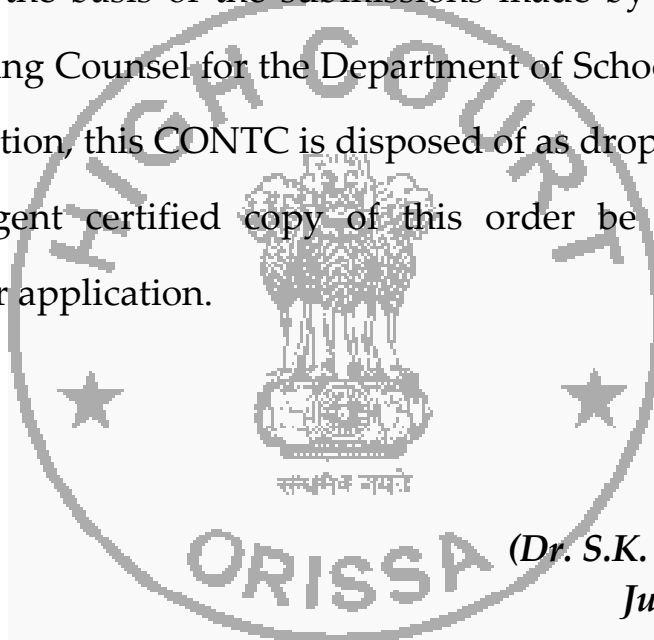

1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
 2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This CONTC has been filed by the Petitioner for non-compliance of the order dated 09.12.2021 passed by this Court in W.P.(C) No.38456 of 2021 directing the Opposite Party/ Contemnor to consider and dispose of the representation of the Petitioner within a period of four months from the date of communication of a certified copy of the order.
