1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Bharatpur P.S. Case No. 108 of 2022 corresponding to C.T. Case No. 1956 of 2022, pending on the file of the learned SDJM, Bhubaneswar for commission of offence under Sections 420/406/387/506/342/451/307/394/294/120(B)/34 of the I.P.C.
4. Taking into account that the nature of allegations and considering the age of the petitioner, this Court directs that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the petitioner shall be released on bail by the learned court in seisin over the matter on such terms as deemed just and proper.
5. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has no criminal proclivity. While enlarging the petitioner on bail the learned court below shall verify such assertion.

If it comes to the fore that the petitioner has any criminal antecedent, this order shall stand recalled automatically without any further reference to this Court.
