1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No. 220 of 2022, arising out of Joda P.S. Case No. 66 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Badbil for the alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections- 147/148/148/186/294/ 323 / 391 / 353 / 506 / 153-A / 120-B /295-A of the I.P.C, and Section 4 PDPP Act and 7 C.L. Act.
4. Taking into account, the nature of allegation, it is directed that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the petitioner shall be released on bail. The
