1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“Issue notices to the Opp.Parties and after hearing the parties further be pleased to quash the Office Order vide Memo No.190/RMC/JYP, dt. 28.02.2022, under Annexure-7 and direct the Opp.Party No.4 to consider the representation of the petitioner under Annexure-5 and 6 for promotion to the post of Jr. Clerk”.

4. He further submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation on 16.08.2021 at Annexure-5 to the Writ Petition, before the Sub-Collector-cum-Chairman, RMC, Jeypore, (opposite party No.4) but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to opposite party No.4 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs opposite party No.4 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
