1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No. 591 of 2022, arising out of Baripada Town P.S. Case No.250 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Baripada for the alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections 363/294/506/34 of I.P.C.
