1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
 2. This application under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. has been filed by the Petitioner with a prayer to quash the order dated 7th June, 2012 passed by the learned Judge, Family, Court, Khurda in CrI.P. No.468 of 2010 wherein the petition for time filed on his behalf has been rejected and allow him to adduce his evidence.
