3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“(i) to admit this writ petition

(ii) to direct the opposite parties more particularly Collector & District Magistrate, Mayurbhanja to make a proper enquiry into the matter and proper compensation and rehabilitation her as per Rule and Regulation of Similipal Tiger Reserve Project; as the petitioner is a poor S.T person, now she has not taken any Rehabilitation and living hither and higher. Immediate action is needful.

And pass any other order/orders, direction/directions as deem fit and proper in the interest of justice.”

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting her grievances, the Petitioner has made a representation to Opposite Party No.3 vide Annexure-7 and the same may be directed to be considered

within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.
