2. This CONTC has been filed for willful disobedience of the Orders dated 21.07.2020 passed by this Court in W.P.(C) No.15632 of 2020, dated 29.07.2020 passed in I.A. No.8306 of 2020 and dated 05.01.2021 passed in CONTC No.5418 of 2020.

3. Learned Counsel for the Opposite Party/Contemnor produces before this Court a copy of the Order No.10648 dated 17.06.2021, vide which the representation of the Petitioner has already been disposed of by passing a reasoned Order and a copy of the same has been marked to the present Petitioner vide Memo No10649 dated 17.06.2021.
